She was principal of Immaculata School in Durham, North Carolina (1954-59); chemistry teacher at Pope Pius XII Regional High School in Passaic (1961-65); psychology professor at Mount Saint Mary College in Newburgh (1965-67); teacher at Cardinal Gibbons High School, Raleigh, North Carolina (1967-68); guidance counselor at Pope Pius XII Regional High School in Passaic (1968-70). She worked in clerical services in Mount Saint Mary College in Newburgh (1971-73) and was supervisor of student teachers at the same college (1973-79).

In 1981 she moved to Gallup, New Mexico, where she was a professor at the University of New Mexico until 1997, when she retired to the Dominican Sisters of Hope Newburgh Center and then Te Wartburg, in Mt. Vernon.
